



ACADEMIC INITIATIVES

On 12.09.2025 students of primary compartment had an activity which explains about the importance of saving forest. They also had learnt about the types of forest.




Students of Grade V learnt the concept of 'Cuboid' through an activity by using the interactive board.



Volume of cuboid











The subjects of historical importance called rock shelters are found inside this park. These rock shelters are the evidence of pre-historic human life in these jungles. They give us an idea of the life of the primitive people who lived in this area long ago. A total of 57 rock shelters have been identified in this area.

The Red Data Book

The Red Data Book is a periodic document prepared by the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN). It lists the status of various species of plants and animals which are in danger of extinction. It also provides information about the reasons for their endangerment and the measures to be taken for their conservation.

PURPOSE OF WILDLIFE SANCTUARIES

Species Protection:
To provide safe havens for threatened and endangered animals, such as blackbucks, elephants, and marsh crocodiles.

Habitat Preservation:
To protect the natural habitats and ecosystems that these species depend on.

Ecological Balance:
To ensure the health and stability of the environment by preventing species extinction and maintaining biodiversity.

On 15.09.2025 and 16.09.2025 all the students from grade VI – IX were taken for an Industrial visit to Hatsun Agro products Ltd.




For the students of **Primary** section **Abacus** class is taken by a **special faculty** once in a week.
